QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Florida teaching certificate.
2. Current employee of the school district.
3. Must be able to relate to and inspire confidence in students.
4. Such alternatives to the above qualifications as the Board may find appropriate and acceptable.

REPORTS TO: Principal/Director or designee

JOB GOAL: Promote the teaching profession, increase student membership in the club, and engage in meaningful club activities to promote student interest.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Works toward student participation in State events.
2. Allows students to see the local teachers' association at work.
3. Tours college campuses.
4. Promotes scholarships and methods of obtaining grants.
5. Assists in planning and supervising fund raising events.
6. Assists officers in planning an exciting calendar for the following year.
7. Assists club members in understanding the bylaws of the Future Educators of America.

OTHER RESPOSNSIBILITIES:

1. Performs related work as required (Note: The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to that position.)
2. Adheres to school district policies and procedures.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

This position requires exerting up to 20 pounds of force occasionally and/or up to 10 pounds of force as frequently as needed to move objects.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:

Dates for the work year are based on the district's school calendar. The work year will be 196 days and a supplement to be determined by Schedule B of the Teacher/District Contract.

ASSESSMENT:

The Principal/Director or designee will assess the effectiveness of the advisor annually with respect to the performance of essential functions.
